2. Any and all video and/or audio containing any criminal violations per Florida State Law.
3. Encrypted, deleted and unallocated files in "The Premises" that contain any of the information listed in previous paragraphs.

GROUNDS FOR ISSUANCE

Evidence relevant to proving a felony has been committed is contained therein. The facts establishing the grounds for this affidavit and the probable cause for believing that such facts exist are detailed below.

PROBABLE CAUSE

Your Affiant is Detective Michelle Mullen, Badge #5525, of the Miami-Dade Police Department. Your Affiant has been a police officer since March of 2003 and has been specifically assigned to the Homicide Bureau since October of 2013. This affidavit is based upon information known personally to your affiant and information obtained from others who have investigated this matter and/or have personal knowledge of the facts herein. Because this affidavit is being submitted for a limited purpose of establishing probable cause, your affiant has not included every aspect, fact, or detail of this investigation.

Your Affiant was assigned as an investigator regarding the Missing Person investigation surrounding the disappearance of LILIANA MORENO, W/Hispanic/F/42, DOB: 12/24/1973, hereinafter referred to as "Victim #01," and DANIELA MORENO, W/Hispanic/F/8, DOB: 10/04/2007, hereinafter referred to as "Victim #02," under case number PD160601206232. Pursuant to investigation, Your Affiant has learned the following: On Tuesday, May 31, 2016, at 8:27 p.m., uniform units from the Doral Police Department were dispatched to 10785 NW 50 Street, Apartment #305, Doral, Florida, in reference to reports of a missing mother and daughter. Upon arrival, units made contact with area neighbors who advised that they had not seen the mother and daughter in several days. Units at the scene also learned from neighbors that "Victim #01" had been involved in a relationship with GUSTAVO ALFONSO CASTANO RESTREPO, W/Hispanic/M/47, DOB: 01/27/1969, hereinafter referred to as "The Suspect." Uniform units later responded to "The Suspect's" residence and determined that the victims were not there.

Uniform units later entered "Victim's #01's" apartment and discovered the apartment unoccupied. Uniform units conducted a cursory search of the apartment and observed within the apartment a cellular telephone, food on the stove, a purse, and car keys. There did not appear to be any signs of a struggle within the apartment. A Toyota Corolla vehicle registered to "Victim

#01" was later observed parked within the apartment complex. Doral Police Department Missing Person Detectives arrived at the scene and assumed the investigation into the disappearance of "The Victims."

Doral Police Department Missing Person Detectives later learned from family members and friends of "Victim #01" that "The Victims" and "The Suspect" met for lunch at a fish restaurant located in the area of Okeechobee Road and the Florida Turnpike on Saturday, May 28, 2016. Doral Police Department Detectives later met with "The Suspect" who provided conflicting accounts as to the whereabouts of the "Victims." According to "The Suspect," on Monday, May 30, 2016, at approximately 11:00 a.m., he responded to "Victim #01's" apartment driving a white van he uses for work. "The Suspect" advised that he entered the apartment. "The Suspect" also advised that "Victim #01" was cooking and asked him if he wanted to eat. "The Suspect" said no, and then requested that "Victim #01" and "Victim #02" accompany him in his van to Home Depot near the Florida Turnpike and Okeechobee Road. "The Suspect" continued, stating that "Victim #01" agreed and he and "Victim #01" and "Victim #02" began traveling north on the Florida Turnpike from NW 74 Street. "The Suspect" added that while driving northbound, he and "Victim #01" became involved in a heated argument. According to "The Suspect," "Victim #01" requested to be dropped off on the Florida Turnpike and Okeechobee Road. "The Suspect" advised that he pulled over to the side of the road and "Victim #01" and "Victim #02" exited. "The Suspect" added that prior to exiting the van, "Victim #01" scratched him on his right forearm. "The Suspect" continued, stating that he drove to his place of employment, located at 10630 NW 123 Street Road, #104, Medley, Florida, and did some work. "The Suspect" advised that he then became concerned for "Victim #01" and "Victim #02," so he drove back to where he dropped them off. "The Suspect" did not find "Victim #01" and "Victim #02," so he drove home to 2148 SW 152 Place, Miami, Florida. "The Suspect" related that when he dropped "Victim #01" and "Victim #02" off, that was the last time he saw them.

Doral Police Detectives requested "The Suspect" provide the address of his place of employment and he advised that he didn't know it. Doral Police Detectives later obtained the address from "The Suspect's" landlord. Despite the fact that "The Suspect" is the biological father of "Victim #02," "The Suspect" did not report "Victim #01" and "Victim #02" missing. Ensuing investigation by Doral Police Department Detectives revealed that on Tuesday, May 31,

2016, at 4:44 p.m. (Colombian time), "The Suspect" telephoned "Victim #01's" sister, Yamileath Moreno Ramirez, W/Hispanic/F, in Colombia, inquiring of the whereabouts of "Victim #01." According to Ms. Moreno Ramirez, "The Suspect" has never called her. Ms. Moreno Ramirez thought it was strange to have received a telephone call from "The Suspect." Ms. Moreno Ramirez then contacted friends that live near "Victim #01" and requested that they check on the welfare of "Victim #01." The friends of "Victim #01" subsequently contacted the Doral Police Department.

On Wednesday, June 1, 2016, your Affiant assisted in obtaining a Search Warrant to search the aforesaid residence in order to retrieve any evidence located therein, to include video and/or audio evidence captured by the recording device(s).

On Wednesday, June 1, 2016, the Search Warrant for the aforesaid residence was executed and resulted in the seizure of "The Premises."

Your Affiant, acting on probable cause that "The Premises" may contain video and/or audio evidence that depicts violations of Florida Statute § 782.04, Murder; seized the Digital Video Recording device because it is clearly an instrumentality and a container for evidence in this crime. Additionally, in order to preserve the integrity of the evidence, Your Affiant ensured that evidence was impounded under police case number PD160601-206232.

WHEREFORE, your Affiant prays that a Search Warrant be issued commanding the Director of the Miami-Dade Police Department, Miami-Dade County, Florida, who is also known as the Sheriff of Miami-Dade County, Florida, or his Deputies, and the Commissioner of the Florida Department of Law Enforcement, or any of his duly constituted agents, and all investigators of the State Attorney of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, with the proper and necessary assistance, to search "The Premises" above-described, and complete a forensic search of "The Property" above-described, making the search in the Daytime or the Nighttime, as the exigencies

may demand or require, or on Sunday, and if the same be found in "The Premises" to seize the same as evidence and to arrest any person in the unlawful possession thereof.





Your Affiant was assigned as an investigator regarding the Missing Persons investigation surrounding the disappearance of Liliana Moreno, W/Hispanic/F/42, DOB: 12/24/1973, hereinafter referred to as "Victim #01," and Daniela Moreno, W/Hispanic/F/8, DOB: 10/04/2007, hereinafter referred to as "Victim #02," under case number PD160601206232.

Pursuant to an investigation, Your Affiant has learned the following:

On Tuesday, May 31, 2016, at approximately 8:00 p.m., uniform units from the City of Doral Police Department were dispatched to 10785 NW 50 Street, #305, Doral, Florida, to check on the



welfare of "Victim #01" and her daughter, "Victim #02," who had been missing.

Upon arrival, units made contact with several friends of "Victim #01" who were concerned for her well-being after not being able to contact her. The units then entered the locked apartment with a key provided by a property manager. Upon entering, the apartment was unoccupied and there did not appear to be any signs of a struggle within the apartment. However, they did discover "Victim #01's" purse and keys inside the residence, as well as food on the stove. In addition, "Victim #01's" vehicle was later observed parked within the apartment complex.

Officers at the scene also learned from neighbors that "Victim #01" had been involved in a relationship with Gustavo Alfonso Castano Restrepo, W/Hispanic/M/47, DOB: 01/27/1969, hereinafter referred to as "The Suspect." Uniform units later responded to "The Suspect's" residence and determined that the victims were not there.

Doral Police Department Missing Person Detectives arrived at the scene and assumed the investigation into the disappearance of "The Victims." Doral Police Department Missing Person Detectives learned from a friend of "Victim #01" that on Saturday, May 28, 2016, "Victim #01," "Victim #02," and "The Suspect" met for lunch at a seafood restaurant located in the area of Okeechobee Road and the Florida Turnpike.

Doral Police Department Detectives later met with "The Suspect," who advised on Monday, May 30, 2016, at approximately 11:00 a.m., he responded to "Victim #01's" apartment. "The Suspect" indicated he entered "Victim #01's" apartment, whereby, he observed "Victim #01" cooking. According to "The Suspect," "Victim #01" offered him something to eat, however, he stated he replied no.

"The Suspect" advised he then requested "Victim #01" and "Victim #02" accompany him to Home Depot near the Florida Turnpike and Okeechobee Road. "The Suspect" continued, stating "Victim #01" agreed, at which time "The Suspect," "Victim #01," and "Victim #02" began traveling north on the Florida Turnpike from NW 74 Street. "The Suspect" added that while driving, he and "Victim #01" became involved in a heated argument.

According to "The Suspect, when he exited the Florida Turnpike onto Okeechobee Road, "Victim #01" indicated she wanted to get out of the vehicle. "The Suspect" advised he pulled over to the side of the road, at which time "Victim #01" and "Victim #02" exited. "The Suspect" added that prior to exiting "The Vehicle," "Victim #01" scratched him on his right forearm.

"The Suspect" continued, stating that he drove to his warehouse, located at 10630 NW 123 Street Road, #104, Medley, Florida, where he stayed for a short time. "The Suspect" advised he then drove back to where he previously dropped "Victim #01" and "Victim #02" off. When "The Suspect" arrived, he did not find "Victim #01" or "Victim #02," so he drove home to 2148 SW 152 Place, Miami, Florida, and parked in the driveway. "The Suspect" related that when he dropped "Victim #01" and "Victim #02" off, it was the last time he saw either of them.

Ensuing investigation by Doral Police Department Detectives revealed that on Tuesday, May 31, 2016, at 4:44 p.m. (Colombian time), "The Suspect" telephoned "Victim #01's" sister, Yamileth Moreno Ramirez, W/Hispanic/F, in Colombia inquiring of the whereabouts of "Victim #01." According to Ms. Moreno Ramirez, "The Suspect" never calls her and thought it was strange to have received a telephone call from "The Suspect." Ms. Moreno Ramirez subsequently contacted friends that live near "Victim #01" and requested that they check on her welfare. "Victim #01's" friends subsequently contacted the Doral Police Department.

During the course of the investigation, Doral Police Department Detectives learned that on Monday, May 30, 2016, "Victim #01's" cellular telephone registered at a cellular phone tower in the area of the Florida Turnpike and Okeechobee Road at 12:57 p.m. Doral Detectives also learned from their investigation that "The Suspect" has a business in the area of Okeechobee Road and the Florida Turnpike, located at 10630 NW 123 Street Road, #104, Medley, Florida. Doral Detectives later responded to the business and learned it had been burglarized.

Doral Detectives also learned that Discount Prints, located 10640 NW 123 Street Road, #105, Medley, Florida, had also been burglarized. Ensuing investigation revealed that the aforementioned business had a closed circuit surveillance system installed and cameras were located at the building exterior. Doral Detectives made contact with the business owner, Raymond Jackson, who advised

that the Digital Video Recorder to the surveillance system was the only item stolen from the business.

Raymond Jackson further advised that on Tuesday, May 31, 2016, "The Suspect" responded to his business inquiring about his surveillance system. Raymond Jackson indicated "The Suspect" entered his warehouse and inspected his Digital Video Recorder. Doral Detectives also learned "The Suspect's" cellular telephone number 786-444-9666, was registering on a cellular tower within close proximity to the warehouse during the time the burglary was occurring.

After inquiring about Raymond Jackson's surveillance system, Raymond Jackson observed "The Suspect" drive to a nearby dumpster. Upon closer examination of the dumpster, Doral Police Detectives located paperwork associated with "Victim #01."

On Wednesday, June 1, 2016, Miami-Dade Police Department Detective Christopher Villano, Badge #5394, assumed the role as the lead detective in the missing person's investigation surrounding the disappearance of "Victim #01" and "Victim #02." During the course of the investigation Miami-Dade Police Department detectives, with the assistance of Doral Police Department detectives interviewed family members of "The Suspect" and "Victim #01." To no avail, through investigative efforts "Victim #01" and "Victim #02" were unable to be located.

On Thursday, June 2, 2016, detectives learned through "The Suspect's" family members that throughout the day "The Suspect" contacted and spoke to each member of his family from Miami, Florida to New Jersey telling them that he loved them and to take care of themselves. In addition, "The Suspect" relinquished \$5,000.00 in paper monies, as well as a new Sears credit card, to his ex-wife.

In addition, detectives learned "The Suspect" rented "The Vehicle" on June 2, 2016, from The Home Depot, located at 13895 W. Okeechobee Road, Hialeah Gardens, Florida. Upon learning of the aforementioned information, a BOLO (be on the lookout) was issued for "The Vehicle."

At approximately 11:40 p.m., Miami-Dade Police Department Homicide Detective Oscar

Andino, Badge #5720, and Detective Michael Mendez, Badge #1853, observed "The Vehicle" in the parking lot of the Home Depot at 13895 W. Okeechobee Road, Hialeah Gardens, Florida. As they approached "The Vehicle," they observed "The Suspect" inside. "The Suspect" then pressed a box cutter against his neck. Officers who responded to the scene were able to restrain "The Suspect," who sustained injuries to his person and was transported to the Kendall Regional Medical Center, admitted in critical, but stable condition.


As of this date, "The Victims" have not been located. Investigation also revealed that "Victim #02" has not attended school within the last week.

"The Vehicle" was towed to Magic Towing located in Hialeah, Florida, pending the issuance of a search warrant.

WHEREFORE, Affiant prays that a Search Warrant be issued commanding the Director of the Miami-Dade Police Department, who is also known as the Sheriff of Miami-Dade County, Florida, or his Deputies, and the Commissioner of the Florida Department of Law Enforcement, or any of his duly constituted agents, all Investigators of the State Attorney of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, all with the proper and necessary assistance, to search the premises above-described, and all spaces therein, and the curtilage thereof, any and/or temporary structures within the curtilage for "The Property" above-described, making the search in the Daytime or the Nighttime, as the exigencies may demand or require, or on Sunday, and if the same be found in the premises to seize the same as evidence.
