#### **INDICTMENT**

The Grand Jury charges that:

#### COUNTS 1-2

On or about March 15, 2016, in Monroe County, in the Southern District of Florida, the defendant,

#### RUSSELL HUDSON CULLEN,

did knowingly possess matter, as set forth in each count below, which contained any visual depiction that had been shipped and transported using any means and facility of interstate and foreign commerce, and in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce, and which was produced using materials which have been so shipped and transported, by any means, including by computer, and the production of such visual depiction having involved the use of a minor engaged in sexually explicit conduct, as defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 2256(2), and such visual depiction was of such conduct:

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2252(a)(4)(B) and (b)(2).

Pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 2252(b)(2), it is further alleged that such visual depiction involved a prepubescent minor and a minor who had not attained twelve years of age.

#### **FORFEITURE ALLEGATIONS**

- 1. The allegations of this Indictment are re-alleged and by this reference fully incorporated herein for the purpose of alleging forfeiture to the United States of America of certain property in which the defendant, RUSSELL HUDSON CULLEN, has an interest.
- 2. Upon conviction of a violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2252, as alleged in this Indictment, the defendant shall forfeit the following property to the United States pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 2253:
- a. any visual depiction of a minor engaged in sexually explicit conduct, and any book, magazine, periodical, film, videotape, or other matter that contains any such visual depiction, which was produced, transported, mailed, shipped or received in violation of Chapter 110 of Title 18, United States Code;
- b. any property, real or personal, constituting or traceable to gross profits or other proceeds which the defendant obtained from such violation; and
- c. any property, real or personal, used or intended to be used to commit or to promote the commission of such violation and any property traceable to such property.

- 3. The property that is subject to forfeiture includes, but is not limited to, the following:
  - a. One (1) Asus laptop, Model: UX32A, SN: 13GNPO1AM020-1-1272-00B7, seized from the defendant on or about March 15, 2016; and
  - b. One (1) Lacie External Hard Drive, SN: 1103612056154C3P3U2F, seized from the defendant on or about March 15, 2016;

All pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 2253, and the procedures set forth at Title 21, United States Code, Section 853, as made applicable by Title 18, United States Code, Section 2253(b).
