Dear Mr. Bennett:

This letter is in response to your request for a Letter of Presumed Death from the U.S. Coast Guard in the disappearance of Mrs. Isabella Hellmann. The U.S. Coast Guard is not authorized to issue a Letter of Presumed Death; however, the information provided below summarizes the efforts of the U.S. Coast Guard in the search for your wife.

On May 15, 2017 at 01:27 a.m. EST, U.S. Coast Guard Seventh District, Miami, Florida received an alert from an Emergency Position Indicating Radio Beacon, followed by a phone call advising that the vessel had struck an unknown object and that Mrs. Hellmann was missing and presumed to be in the water 26 nautical miles west of Cay Sal, BS. The U.S. Coast Guard leveraged available resources, including a HC-144 fixed-wing aircraft; a HC-130 fixed-wing aircraft; a CG Fast Response Cutter; a MH-65 helicopter; a MH-60 helicopter; and a Cuban Search and Rescue 14M patrol craft.

The Coast Guard dedicated a combined 137.77 hours spanning 4,980 square nautical miles with four types of aircrafts and three CG cutters. Unfortunately, our search assets were unable to locate your wife, Isabella.

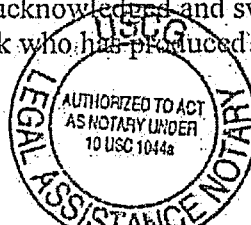
