On July 13, 2018, the department received a report regarding the death of one-year-old [REDACTED] who was pronounced deceased after he was accidentally left in a car all day while his mother was working. At the time of the incident, the family had been residing with friends while their house was being tented, and the mother [REDACTED] who had been under a lot of stress, was taking a different route to work. After finishing her day, [REDACTED] proceeded to [REDACTED] daycare, where she believed she dropped him off that morning. Upon being informed that [REDACTED] had never arrived at the facility, [REDACTED] began to realize what had occurred.

[REDACTED] drove back to the hospital where she worked and medical staff began to administer resuscitation efforts [REDACTED] was transported to a larger hospital where he was pronounced dead upon his arrival.
