On July 13, 2018, the department received a report regarding the death of one-year-old who was pronounced deceased after he was accidentally left in a car all day while his mother was working. At the time of the incident, the family had been residing with friends while their house was being tented, and the mother who had been under a lot of stress, was taking a different route to work. After finishing her day, proceeded to daycare, where she believed she dropped him off that morning. Upon being informed that had never arrived at the facility, began to realize what had occurred.
